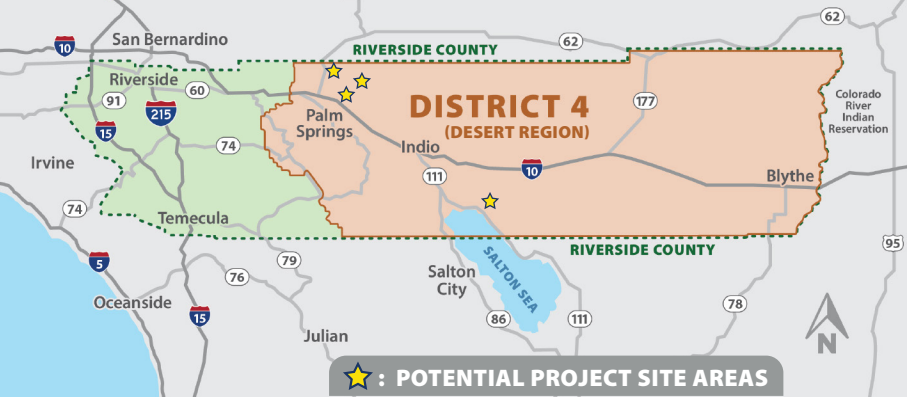
The feasibility study will assess potential sites and various factors to explore the viability of establishing a park that aligns with our local environment, providing recreational opportunities for all ages.
